


TSAN - 6 Step Responsibility Trajectory

Taking Transformative Actions








Think of the variety of skills and expertise based on the varied experiences you developed to date. We need to be more introspective, and bring these readily available skills to bear on the changes we want to see.

Context

Consider the following reflective questions:

- In what way have your actions and lifestyle impacted the environment, or your community as a whole?

- What is your assessment of past actions, in terms of how your actions have been perceived or received by others? Key words to inform appropriate actions which can be applied in order to make a difference, regardless of the challenges.



TSAN - template for action planning

Track, measure and review trends and progress. Evaluate, recalibrate and maintain or improve on agreed standards

Launch, embed and follow through on establishing sustainable ethos, processes, practices and mindsets to ensure impact

Your defined responses / action steps make up your personal or group's action plan Use your God inspired knowledge, skills, strengths and experiences, to plan and deliver impactful solutions

> What solutions would you like to implement?

Increase social impact by using appropriate resources, innovation, information, partnerships (coconstruction) leveraging networks, etc. Identify success criteria, benchmarked against appropriate standards (Use the SDGs)

> Develop sustainable strategies, systems and structures

Thinking about the possible barriers to implementing your proposed changes, and possible ways to remove these barriers.

Identify the source of your funding and support to assist with carrying out your proposed action steps. (Identify the available grants to be applied for?)

Do you have enough time to carry out these changes? Are these action steps things people can get excited about?

Come up with a list of partners you could work with, and a list of possible volunteers you might require.

> What kind of opposition can you expect if you put your plan into effect? Are there ways to get around

> > it?

TTGHH 6 – Step Responsibility Trajectory

AGENCY:

Human agency can be described as 'an individual's capacity to determine and make meaning from their environment through purposive consciousness and reflective and creative action,' (Houston, 2010)

... understand the need to develop the right agency to support transformative actions.

> ... able to reflect and assess how your convictions towards the SDGs can be translated to practical actions.

> > ... able to further develop the appropriate knowledge, skills and capabilities to enable implementation of the necessary transformation actions towards meeting the SDGs.
